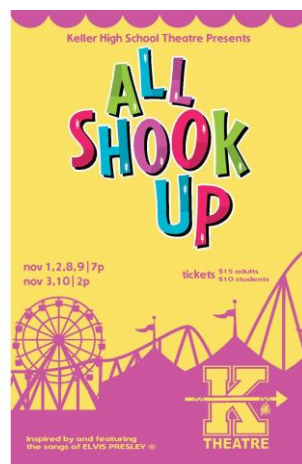
ALL SHOOK UP CLASSIC CAR SHOW
